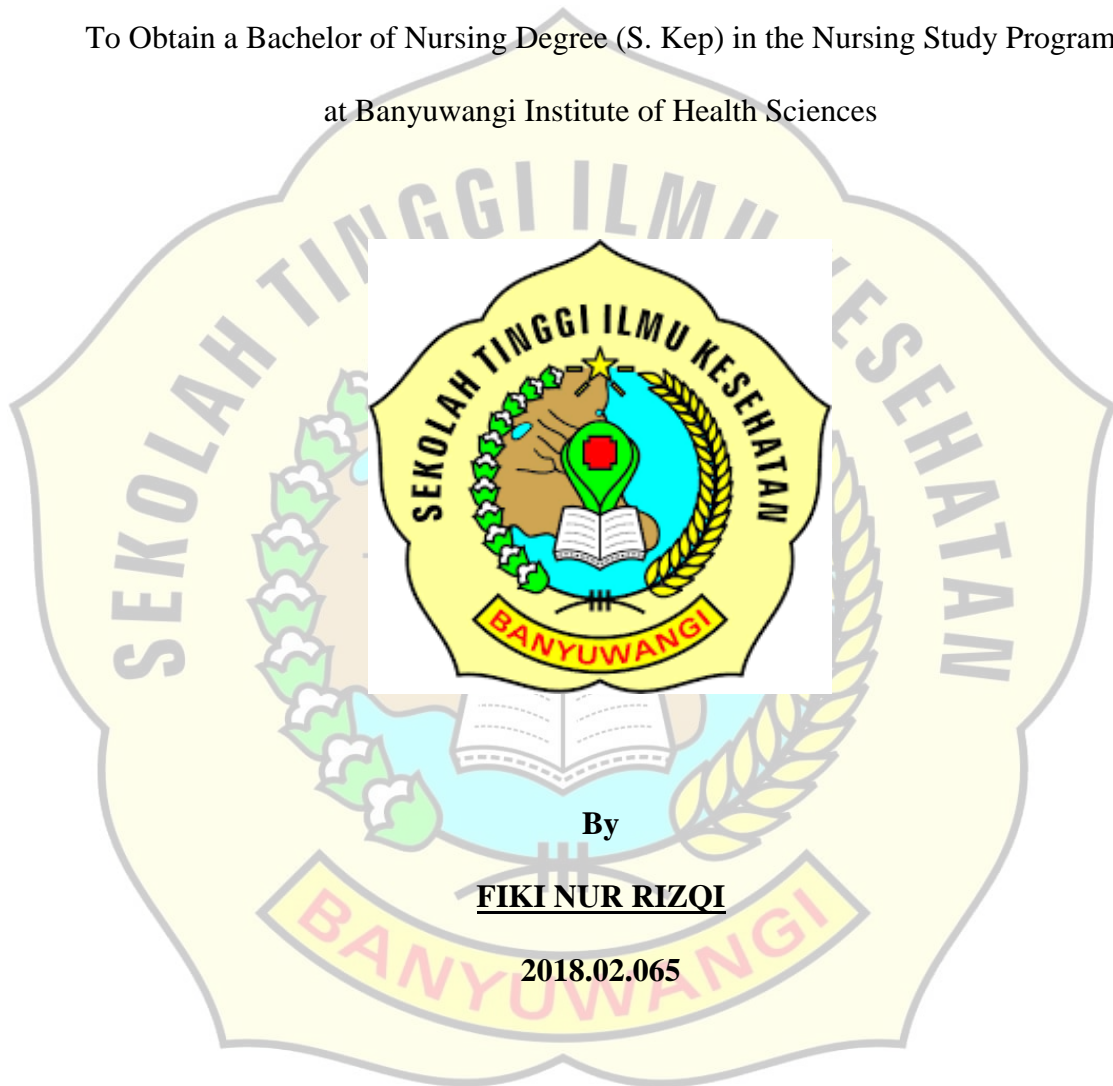

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ABSTRACT
THE EXPERIENCE OF COVID-19 VACCINE PROGRAM IN THE
COMMUNITY OF BANYUWANGI REGENCY:
AN EXPLORATION STUDY

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Background: The Covid-19 vaccine program is one of the Indonesian government's efforts in dealing with the Covid-19 problem. The government's plan to implement a Covid-19 vaccine program in Indonesia has received various responses from the public. The difference in knowledge gained will affect the vaccination experience for each individual. The purpose of this study is to discuss the experience of the Covid-19 vaccine program in the people of Banyuwangi Regency. **Methods:** Qualitative research using phenomenological research design with Colaizzi data analysis method. The sampling technique used purposive sampling and obtained 11 participants. The approach used in this research is to use observation techniques and in-depth interviews. Data validity uses credibility, dependability, confirmability, and transferability. The inclusion criteria in this study were that the age of the participants was more than 18 years with a minimum of having received the first dose of the Covid-19 vaccine. **Results:** In this study, 4 themes and 14 sub-themes were realized. The 4 themes are understanding about vaccine, support systems, self motivation, and survive for side effect. **Conclusion:** The experience of the Covid-19 vaccine program in Banyuwangi Regency depends on the understanding obtained, an adequate support system, strong self-motivation, and resistance to the effects caused after vaccination so that increased education is needed to achieve maximum understanding.

ABSTRAK

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Latar Belakang: Program vaksin Covid-19 merupakan salah satu upaya pemerintah Indonesia dalam menangani masalah Covid-19. Rencana pemerintah untuk menerapkan program vaksin Covid-19 di Indonesia mendapat berbagai tanggapan dari masyarakat. Perbedaan pengetahuan yang diperoleh akan mempengaruhi pengalaman vaksinasi pada setiap individu. Tujuan dari penelitian ini adalah untuk membahas pengalaman program vaksin Covid-19 pada masyarakat Kabupaten Banyuwangi. **Metode:** Penelitian kualitatif menggunakan desain penelitian fenomenologi dengan metode analisis data Colaizzi. Teknik pengambilan sampel menggunakan purposive sampling dan diperoleh 11 partisipan. Pendekatan yang digunakan dalam penelitian ini adalah dengan menggunakan teknik observasi dan wawancara mendalam. Validitas data menggunakan kredibilitas, ketergantungan, konfirmabilitas, dan transferabilitas. Kriteria inklusi dalam penelitian ini adalah usia partisipan lebih dari 18 tahun dengan minimal pernah menerima vaksin Covid-19 dosis pertama. **Hasil:** Dalam penelitian ini direalisasikan 4 tema dan 14 subtema. Keempat tema tersebut adalah pemahaman tentang vaksin, sistem pendukung, motivasi diri, dan bertahan hidup untuk efek samping. **Kesimpulan:** Pengalaman program vaksin Covid-19 di Kabupaten Banyuwangi tergantung dari pemahaman yang didapat, sistem pendukung yang memadai, motivasi diri yang kuat, dan ketahanan terhadap efek yang ditimbulkan setelah vaksinasi sehingga diperlukan peningkatan edukasi untuk mencapai pemahaman yang maksimal.

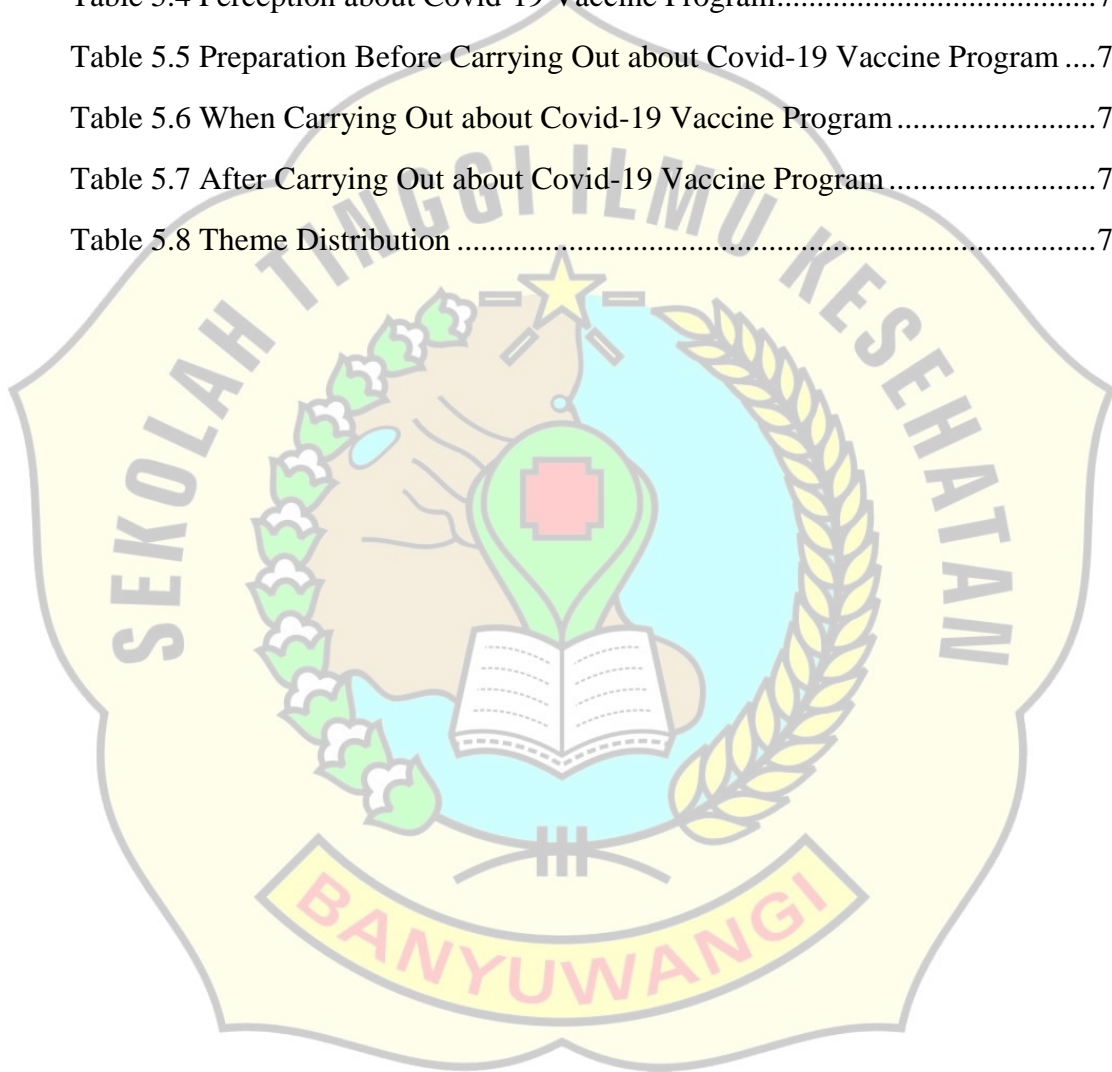

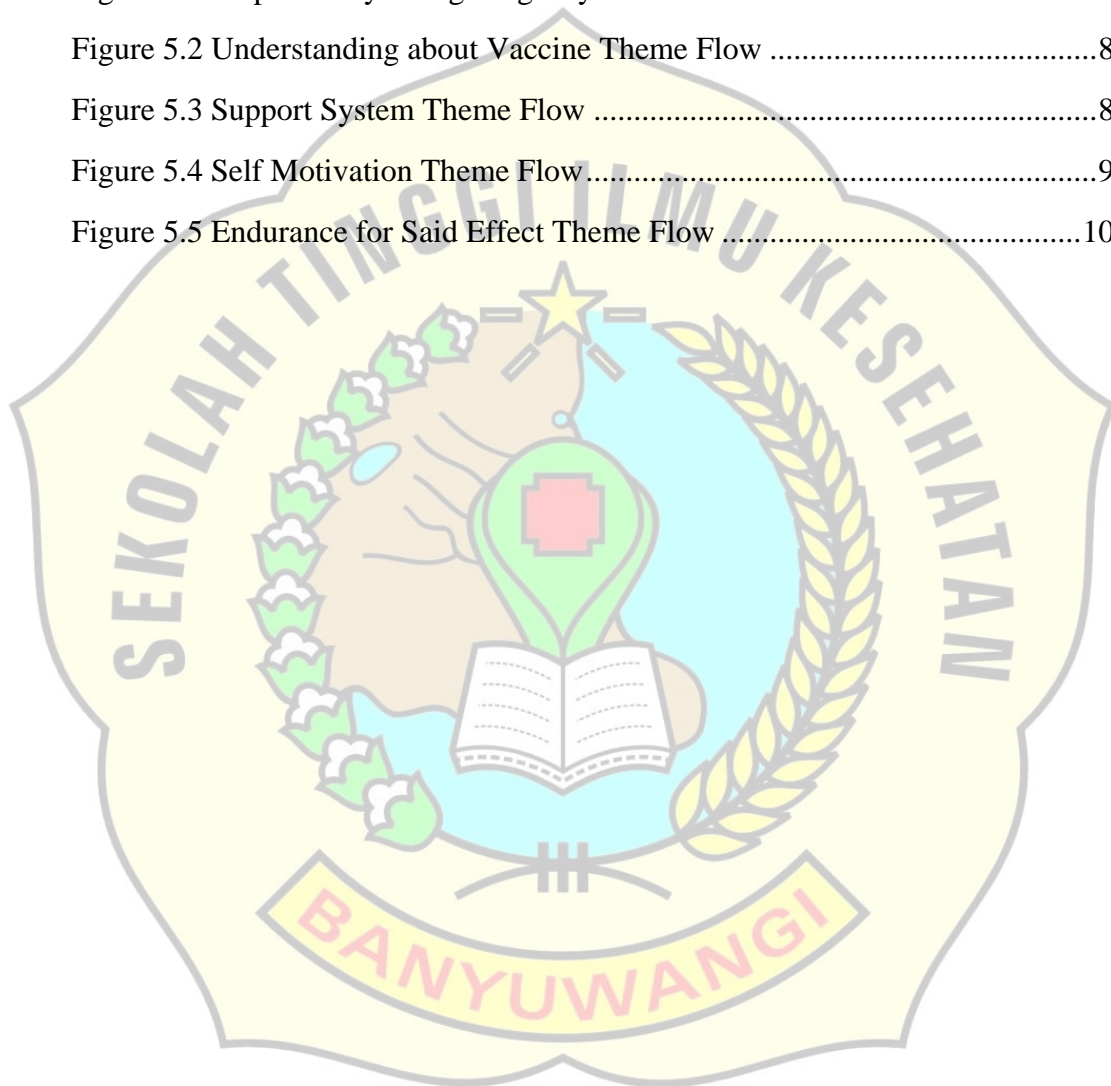
